Jupiter

The largest planet in the solar system, and the fifth in the order of distance from the Sun. It is visible to the naked eye, except for short periods when in near conjunction with the Sun. Usually it is the second brightest planet in the sky; only Mars at its maximum luminosity and Venus appear brighter

It has 318 times the mass and more than 1,400 times the volume of Carth. Its enormous mass gives it nearly 2.5 times the gravity of Carth (measured at the top of Jupiter's atmosphere), and it exerts strong effects on other members of the solar system. It is responsible for the Kirkwood gaps in the asteroid belt and changes in the orbits of comets; it may act as a "sweeper," pulling in bodies that might otherwise collide with other planets. Jupiter has more than 60 moons and a diffuse ring system discovered in 1979 by the Voyager spacecraft. The planet is a gas giant, composed mainly of hydrogen and helium in proportions near those of the Sun, which it orbits every 11.9 years at an average distance of 483 million mi (778 million km). Its rapid rotation (9 hr 55.5 min) acts on electric currents to give it the largest magnetic field of any of the planets and causes intense storms, including one that has lasted hundreds of years. Little is known of its interior, but it is presumed to have a deep layer of

metallic hydrogen and a dense core. Its central temperature is estimated to be 45,000 °F (25,000 °C); it radiates twice as much heat as it receives from the Sun, probably largely heat left over from its formation.



Jupiter. It is quite right that it is named after the Roman King of the Gods. Jupiter is so massive that, by itself, it accounts for more than 70% of the mass of all the planets in the solar system. It gives off more energy than it gets from the Sun; it has storms that are big enough to swallow up a few

Jupiter spins on its own axis faster than any other planet ~ its "day is slightly less than 10 hours long! This is why Jupiter looks "flattened" at the Poles. Some of the surface winds have been clocked at over 400 km/hr. Jupiter is about 150,000 km across, about one tenth of the size of the Sun. Basically, it is a giant ball of gas, with a solid core. At the centre it is solid, because of the pressure of the overlying layers. The pressure is enormous ~ about 45 million times more than the pressure at sea level on Earth. Above the solid core are a layer of liquid hydrogen, and then several layers of various gases, including hydrogen and helium There are also several trace gases, including unstable compounds of arsenic and phosphorus. Scientists have been trying to explain why these unstable gases are there.

Like the three other giant gas planets, Jupiter has a set of rings. These rings are very flimsy and hard to see, as compared to the magnificent rings of Saturn. There are less than 30 km thick.

One of the astonishing things about Jupiter is the Great Red Spot. It is an enormous oval - about 14,000 km by 35,000 km. It's big enough to swallow two or three of our planet Earths lying side by side! This strange weather pattern is incredibly stable. It has looked practically the same ever since it was first seen over 340 years ago. It actually stands some 8 km above the surrounding atmosphere - roughly the height of Mt. Everest. As is proper for the King of the Planets, Jupiter has its own collection of about 16 satellites. One of them, lo, has as many as 8 volcanoes erupting at a time. Some of these eruptions reach up more than 100 km!

Some of the moons are bigger than our own Moon. Some of them are covered with water ice - and they probably have oceans of water under the ice, and maybe even living creatures in this water. These moons would get most of their energy from Jupiter, not the Sun. To us, the radiation from Jupiter is fatal. But to these (possible) creatures, Jupiter would appear as a large friendly glowing source of life energy in the sky.

There could even be strange blimp-like floating creatures that live in the thick atmosphere of Jupiter. They could be the cause of the unstable gases in Jupiter's atmosphere. They could move by sucking in gas and squirting it out, and could breathe out the faint garlic-like odour of arsenic compounds. But we won't know until we send more robot spacecraft explorers to take a closer long-term look at Jupiter and its satellites

Jupiter has 15 moons, 4 of which are visible to Earth through a telescope. It is the 5th planet away from the sun

In the natal chart it is considered the planet of good luck, optimism, success, generosity. Jupiter brings joy to life. It is the planet of expansiveness and abundance. Jupiter is the planet of greater fortune (Venus is the planet of lesser fortune). Jupiter rules over luck, heath, happiness, wealth, and worldly goods, knowledge, higher learning, vision and honesty. Jupiter imparts philosophical wisdom, whereas Mercury imparts day to day eleverness.

The Babylonian equivalent of Jupiter was Marduk, King of the Gods. The story of creation is centered around him. The primordial sea serpent, Tiamat, revolted against the gods. Marduk was chosen as their champion and he defeated the armies of darkness and killed Tiamat. Marduk fashioned the earth and sky from the remains of Tiamat's gigantic corpse. He put the stars in the heavens and created the calendar.

The Greek god, Zeus, who became Jupiter in Roman mythology, drew lots with his brothers to share the Universe. Hades drew the underworld, Poseidon drew the sea and Zeus became the supreme ruler. He was Lord of the Sky, the god of rain and the gatherer of clouds who controlled the thunderbolt. His power was greater than all the others, but he was not omnipotent or omniscient.

Zeus had the power to elevate to immortality, to release from suffering, and place among the stars, as he did Chiron, Sagittarius, Hercules and Calisto. He could also condemn as he did Prometheus, Cronus and Asclepius. Zeus had a special throne at the top of Mr.

Olympus where he could see everything below. On Zeus' shoulders were 2 ravens named Thought and Memory who advised him.

Jupiter is a significator of good fortune and good fellowship. In Latin, he is called Jove, hence the word jovial. Jupiter(Zeus) was the God of Thunder and could be terrifying at times. Like his daughter, Athene, his armor pictured Medusa's face and his bird was the eagle. The oak tree was sacred to Zeus, a symbol of his kingship. The priests at his temple in Podona, divined the future by listening to the rustling of the wind through a grove of oak trees





Zadkiel is thought by some to be one of the seven archangels who stand before God.


In "The Zohar" Zadkiel is represented as one of two chieftains, the other being Zaphiel, who assists the great Archangel Michael when he bears his standard in battle.

Once you have been attuned to the energies of the Planet Jupiter, you are able to pass them on to others.

The procedure is very simple...there are only two symbols, plus the Sacred Phoenix Symbol which seals in all the energies. The symbols are sent to you as one attunement.

You may like to light a candle, play some music or anything else that makes you feel relaxed.

Ask for protection from your Guides, Angels, Great White Spirit, or whoever you relate to. It doesn't matter who it is as long as you feel safe in their presence then start to send the energies and the symbols to your student.

Feel the energy coming out of your crown and heart chakras and going to the student.

If you feel that you want to use the Reiki distance symbol at any time, then you can, but it is not necessary.

When you feel that the energy has stopped flowing, then thank your "helpers" and you are finished.



A suggested Meditation for receiving the Energies

Find a place where you will not be disturbed. Sit quietly and let yourself relax. Picture yourself lying on a deserted beach, or some beautiful soft green grass, or on the deck of an ocean going liner.

It is night and the sky is filled with millions of blue-white glittering stars. Just gaze at them in your mind's eye....feel your eyes getting very heavy and feel a soft, gentle breeze wafting around you like a delicate silk scarf. Now, picture the Planet Jupiter, shining so brightly like a jewel in the sky. Take note of her moons and the rings surrounding her.

As you watch her turning very slowly on her axis you become aware of two symbols leaving the orbit of your planet and gently floating to earth towards you. One is quicker than the other...you can feel the energies from it and as it gets closer they become stronger and stronger. Feel those powerful energies, feel the symbol melt into your body. Feel the power and the wisdom and the knowledge. Allow it to be.

Let go of all external influences and relax into the moment.

What do you see, what do you feel?

Everyone will experience something different as it brings to you only what you need.

After a few moments you are aware that the other symbol is now right in front of you. Draw it into your energy field too and feel the love and warmth as the 2 symbols merge...they are like twin flames they belong to each other and now they belong to you.

You may call on these symbols at any time that you need to re-charge or re-connect with the special energies of Uranus.

Spend as much time as you need absorbing the ancient knowledge then when you are ready slowly come back to reality. Take a couple of deep breaths and thank your guides and higher self for taking you on this journey.
