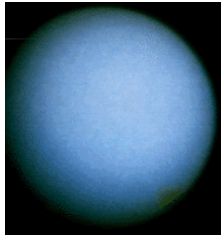

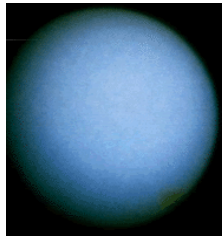

Pluto



The icy, enigmatic planet of Pluto is the ninth and furthest planet from our sun.

The planet Pluto is also the smallest in our solar system; it is even smaller than many of the moons that orbit other planets.

Pluto is a force for change that can be destructive in its power.

Pluto rules Scorpio, and is exalted in Leo.

Pluto is related to will, and intense passion, and has a reputation for ruthlessness.

As god of the underworld Pluto brings the deepest compulsions into the light. Its position indicates areas of life that must ultimately become transformed as part of the soul's evolution.

Pluto: Your Need For Fundamental Change

The planet Pluto represents the dark underground part of you. It shows your ability to transform the most fundamental properties in your own inner nature. The sign of Pluto is the way the obsessive, compulsive and committed part of your nature expresses itself. The house placement of Pluto shows the area of life where you make your most fundamental and most potent changes. The aspects to Pluto show the deepest most unconscious links in your personality structure.





Pluto was the God of the Dead.

When someone died, they travelled down to the Underworld.

First, they had to cross the River of the Dead, called the Styx. Everyone was buried with a coin, to pay the ferryman, Charon.

Then they had to get past Cerberus, a fierce dog with three heads, which would only let the Dead through.

Finally they had to come before the Judges of the Dead.

The only living man to fight Cerberus was Hercules, the strongest man in the world.

He had to bring Cerberus back from the Underworld. (He let it go afterwards.)



The moon of planet Pluto is called Charon.

The metal Plutonium is radio-active. It was discovered soon after the planet Pluto.

It is not only used for nuclear bombs, it is deadly by itself.

It deserves to belong to the god of Death!



Pluto' glyph, or symbol, combines the circle (spirit) over the crescent (receptivity) and the cross (matter).

This glyph suggests spiritual receptivity to "superworlds" or the superconscious, placed above the physical world.

A more common, although perhaps somewhat outdated, glyph for Pluto merges the letters P and Q (which are the initials of the man who discovered Pluto, Percival Lowell), and is pictured here at right.

Pluto is a tiny planet which has an erratic orbit. It takes 10 to 12 years to complete one cycle of the zodiac.

Sometimes it moves very slowly taking over 30 years to complete one sign. Pluto takes approximately 248 years to make one cycle through all twelve signs.

The period Pluto spends in each sign can vary from twelve years to thirty two years due to the eccentricity of its orbit

Though it is smaller in size, its energy is enormous.

Pluto governs complete transformations, death, the underworld, volcanoes and deep spiritual matters.

The presence and direction of Pluto's energy are never obvious until it is used.

Pluto's influence in any sign is interpreted as generational or historical.

In your personal life, Pluto's significance is interpreted from its house position and the aspects it makes to other natal planets in your horoscope.

Pluto rules intense energy, and describes the areas in which you consciously or subconsciously seek to exercise power or control. Pluto is also linked to your karmic responsibility. Called "the great renewer";

Pluto is considered to represent the part of a person that destroys in order to renew.

A commonly used keyword for Pluto is "transformation".

Pluto is also associated with extreme power and corruption;

the discovery of Pluto in 1930 coincided with the rise of fascism and Stalinism in Europe, leading to the Second World War.

It also coincided with the Great Depression and the major proliferation of organized crime in the United States.

Its entry into Cancer in 1913, the sign in which it was later discovered, coincided with the First World War.

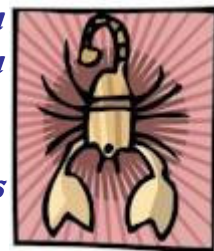
It is also associated with nuclear armament, which had its genesis in the research of the 1930's and 40's.

Later on, it gave rise to the polarised nuclear stand off of the Cold War, with the mass consumer societies of the United States and other democracies facing the totalitarian Musical Notge associated with Plutostate socialism of the USSR.

The discovery of Pluto also occurred just after the birth of modern psycho-analysis, when Freud and Jung began to explore the depths of the unconscious.

In art, movements like Cubism and Surrealism began to deconstruct the 'normal' view of the world and reassemble it in new and sometimes disturbing ways

Scorpions have "two lobster-like claws"⁽¹⁾ and when a scorpion captures its victims with its claws, it "inflicts a disabling sting with its tail"



Scorpios are thought to be rather cunning, and sometimes revengeful.

Dual nature of Scorpio:

A second symbol for Scorpio is the Eagle.

The Golden Eagle "has been regarded from ancient times as a symbol of courage and power".

The eagle represents clear vision, intelligence, and power.

It is a majestic bird, and also symbolizes freedom.

Scorpios, with their perceptiveness, have the potential to "see" things more clearly than others.

How they handle the power of this vision will depend on whether they are at the level of a scorpion or an eagle!



Scorpio's glyph, or symbol, looks like a letter M with a tail.

The curves show the grounded nature of the sign, ending in an upward-turned arrow, symbolizing the need for action and the striving for something higher.

Some believe the symbol represents the male genitals -- the sign of Scorpio is strongly connected to sex

Symbols for Scorpio are the scorpion, a ground-dwelling killer with a poisonous sting in its tail and the eagle, a far-seeing predator soaring above petty problems into the spiritual sky.

Scorpio's real involvement is not primarily based on love or even pleasure, but on the control and understanding of human emotions and the role they play in the mysterious processes of life and death.

Though you may not spend your life pondering the mysteries of life and death, you are inquisitive and probing, fascinated with how things and people work.

Your mental and physical powers of recuperation are remarkable and truly evolved (eagle) Scorpios can learn to use their power to help and inspire others.



You can sense this intense Scorpio energy everywhere, especially in the Quarter.

But also consider that Scorpio is ruled by the planet Pluto; the planet of death and transformation; of breaking down and rebuilding.

Number

Zero is ruled by the planet Pluto, which gives it many transforming and regenerating qualities. It has a lot of depth and intensity, which makes it an abstruse number indeed.

In numerology Pluto vibrates to the number 0 (zero)

Zero is a powerful number which brings great transformational change, sometimes occurring in a profound manner. It has much intensity, so caution is needed wherever it appears to ensure that extremes are not encountered.

Zero represents the Cosmic Egg, the primordial Androgyne - the Plenum. Zero as an empty circle depicts both the nothingness of death and yet the totality of life contained within the circle. As an ellipse the two sides represent ascent and descent, evolution and involution.

Before the One (meaning the Source--not the number) there is only Void, or non-being; thought; the ultimate mystery, the incomprehensible Absolute. Begins with meanings such as, Non-existence; nothingness; the unmanifest; the unlimited; the eternal. The absence of all quality or quantity.

Taoism: It symbolizes the Void; non-being.

Buddhism: It is the Void and no-thingness.

Kabbalism: Boundless; Limitless Light; the Ain.

Pathagoras saw zero as the perfect. Zero is the Monad, the originator and container of All.

Islamic: Zero is the Divine Essence.

Pluto and Plutonium

*Underground millionaire Pluto lord of Death
Allen Ginsberg, Plutonian Ode (1)*

When Uranium was discovered in 1789, it was named after the new planet Uranus, found in 1781.

No further elements beyond Uranium were discovered until after Pluto's appearance.

Uranium was the ninety-second element in the Periodic Table of elements, and when the next two elements in this sequence turned up, elements 93 and 94, there was a kind of inevitability about their naming.

They had to be named after the next two planets, and so were called neptunium and plutonium - both found at Berkeley using the new cyclotron.

Glen Seaborg who named the new element had (it hardly needs saying) no inkling of the awful symbolic appropriateness of the name he was giving.

He would have guessed it would be fissile, that's about all.

Within the core of nuclear reactors, a transmutation-process goes through the sequence of the outer planet-names:

Uranium 238 to Uranium 239 to Neptunium to Plutonium 239

The uranium-cycle is:

- *Earth: Uranium is mined;*
- *Air: a winnowing separates the isotopes, the fissile U-235 from the denser U-238 which remains as 'depleted uranium';*
- *Fire: in the heat of the reactor core, the uranium chain-reacts and plutonium is bred; and then*
- *Water: in nitric acid baths, the spent reactor fuel is dissolved and thereby the plutonium is separated out*

Chakra Association

In ancient times the only planets known were those visible to the naked eye

For this reason the newer planets, Neptune, Uranus and Pluto were not included in many of the planetary associations

After their discovery, some of them have been added as a new version.

Third Eye Chakra

But because Neptune and Pluto also share the same basic orbital, relative to the Sun (388.0, according to Bode's Law), this Chakra would also represent Pluto, which rules the sign of Scorpio and symbolises the underworld, death, and transformation.

Third Eye center

Christ consciousness center

Location: At the base of the skull, at the medula oblongata.

It's location at the front of the head is between the eyebrows at the third eye.

Colour: Indigo. A combination of blue and red.

Tone: OM

(O represents the Sun or the third eye) (M represents the Moon or medulla.)

Element: Electrical or telepathic energy.

Sense: Thought





The third eye is the center of psychic powers and higher intuition, you can receive guidance, channeling, and tune into your higher self.

This is the center that enables you to experience telepathy, astral travel and past lives.

Balanced energy:

Charismatic, can receive guidance, not attached to material things, no fear of death, master of yourself,

sexual energy- you no longer need another person to complete yourself.

Gems/Minerals:

Judgement



Basic Tarot Meaning

With Fire as its ruling element (or Pluto as its ruling planet), Judgement is about rebirth, resurrection

The idea of Judgement day is that the dead rise, their sins are forgiven, and they move onto heaven.

The Judgement card is similar, it asks the resurrection to summon the past, forgive it, and let it go. There are wounds from the past that we never let heal, sins we've committed that we refuse to forgive, bad habits we haven't the courage to lose. Judgement advises us to finally face these, recognize that the past is past, and put them to rest, absolutely and irrevocably.

This is also a card of healing, quite literally from an accident or illness, as well as a card signalling great transformation, renewal, change.

Gem stones associated with Pluto

Amethyst--Purple quartz. Assists spiritual/psychic opening in a grounded way, creativity, courage, intuition, self esteem.



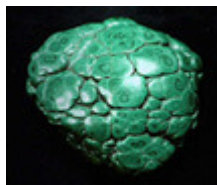
Clear Quartz--Powerful transmitter, amplifies/directs thought forms, healing energy balancer, promote clarity, attunes one to higher self



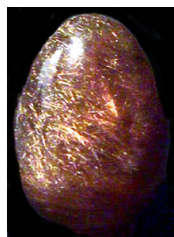
Garnet--Circulation (especially in lungs, skin, intestines), promotes heat, energy, vitality, strengthens imagination, self-esteem, willpower



Malachite--Balance right/left brain, mental illness, overtoxication protects against radiation, promotes tissue regeneration, inspires giving of self, self expression, assists vision on all levels.



Rutilated Quartz--Helps break old patterns, childhood blockages, tissue regeneration, builds immune system, eases depression



Herbs associated with Pluto

Herbs associated with Pluto are galangal root, pennyroyal and musk. Although mushrooms are often associated with the Moon or Neptune, they can be appropriate in a Pluto ritual

Galangal

Galanga has many medicinal properties similar to ginger. It is a digestive stimulant and also helps to settle stomach upsets, ease nausea and curb flatulence. Traditional herbal doctors recommend a tonic made of minced and pounded old galanga root, mixed with tamarind water and salt, for women who have just given birth, as a blood purifier and as an aid in the removal of gas build-up in the intestines. At the same time, its mild, natural laxative effect keeps the bowels regular. Galanga's heat makes it a good agent in reducing cramping and numbness, in healing bruises and swelling, in treating respiratory ailments and skin diseases and in removing toxins from the body.

In addition, kah is sometimes classified among the category of herbs we call wahn, which are reputed to have magical powers. This belief coincides with an account I once read about its use in medieval Europe among certain medicine people, who wore the dried root as a protection against evil influences and as an enhancer of virility. Known as "galingale" during that period, it was widely used as an aphrodisiac as well as a spice. Somehow, it disappeared from European culinary and medical scenes, and some historians have surmised that it fell out of vogue, along with other spices, as milder foods became the order of the day in the eighteenth century. Today, as Thai cuisine grows in popularity on that continent, perhaps galingale will regain its favored position.



Pennyroyal

---Medicinal Action and Uses---Pliny gives a long list of disorders for which Pennyroyal was a supposed remedy, and especially recommends it for hanging in sleeping rooms, it being considered by physicians as more conducive to health even than roses. It was likewise thought to communicate its purifying qualities to water, and Gerard tells us:

'If you have Pennyroyale in great quantity dry and cast it into corrupt water, it helpeth it much, neither will it hurt them that drink thereof.' As a purifier of the blood, it was highly spoken of: Penny-royale taken with honey cleanseth the lungs and clearerth the breast from all gross and thick humours.'

'It was deemed by our ancestors valuable in headaches and giddiness. We are told: 'A garland of Penny-royale made and worn about the head is of great force against the swimming in the head and the pains and giddiness thereof.'

'Pennyroyal Water was distilled from the leaves and given as an antidote to spasmodic, nervous and hysterical affections. It was also used against cold and 'affections of the joints.'

Culpepper says of Pennyroyal:

'Drank with wine, it is good for venomous bites, and applied to the nostrils with vinegar revives those who faint and swoon. Dried and burnt, it strengthens the gums, helps the gout, if applied of itself to the place until it is red, and applied in a plaster, it takes away spots or marks on the face; applied with salt, it profits those that are splenetic, or liver grown.... The green herb bruised and put into vinegar, cleanses foul ulcers and takes away the marks of bruises and blows about the eyes, and burns in the face, and the leprosy, if drank and applied outwardly.... One spoonful of the juice sweetened with sugar-candy is a cure for hooping-cough.'

'Its action is carminative, diaphoretic, stimulant and emmenagogic, and is principally employed for the last-named property in disorders caused by sudden chill or cold. It is also beneficial in cases of spasms, hysteria, flatulence and sickness, being very warming and grateful to the stomach.'



Musk

Originally Musk came from a gland In the Musk Deer. It is used frits perfumeThe same perfume is also found in plants

The musk plant (Mimulus moschatus). In the vegetable kingdom it was present in the musk flower (Mimulus moschatus), the musk wood of the Guianas and West Indies, and in the seeds of Abelmoschus moschatus (musk seeds).

However, mimulus is today largely scentless, all specimens having almost simultaneously lost their distinctive odor for no apparent reason in the mid-twentieth century.

Musk, or nodding thistle is an aggressive, biennial herb with showy red-purple flowers and painful spiny stems and leaves.

Mature plants range in height from 1 to 6 feet tall, and have multi-branched stems.

Leaves are dark green, coarsely lobed, with a smooth waxy surface and a yellowish to white spine at the tip.

The large disk-shaped flower heads, containing hundreds of tiny individual flowers, are 1 to 3 inches in length and occur at the tips of stems.

Flower heads will droop to a 90-degree angle from the stem when mature, hence its alternate name, nodding thistle. Each plant may produce thousands of straw-colored seeds adorned with plume-like bristles

Celtic Tree Lore Reed Lore

* **12th Moon of the Celtic Year** - (Oct 28 - Nov 24)

* *In Britain the dwarf elm, also called the Water-Elder, Whitten, or rose Petal, is known as the Reed tree. It is sometimes suggested that the North American equivalent to this would be the cattail or horsetail reed. I live in a swamp and trust me, cattails are not trees - therefore I prefer to just use the immature Elm tree in place of Reed.*

* *Latin name: American Elm - *ulmus americana*; European Elm - *ulmus procera*; slippery Elm - *ulmus fulva*.*

* *Celtic name: Negetal (pronounced: nyettle).*

* *Folk or Common names: In Britain where the Reed tree is the dwarf elm, it is called the Water-Elder, Whitten, or rose Petal. Since I use the immature Elm tree in place of the Reed tree, the Elm is usually known as Elm, and sometimes Piss-Elm (due to the smell it makes while being burned as a green wood).*

* *Parts used: Bark, leaves, wood.*

* *Herbal usage: The Elm has many medicinal uses. Slippery Elm bark can be powdered and made into a milk for babies that can't tolerate cow's milk. In fact slippery Elm bark is good for many purposes. In tea it can ease insomnia and sooth an upset tummy. It is also useful for enemas and makes good poultice material. This type of poultice can be used on wounds, infections, ulcers, burns, and poison ivy.*

- *Magickal History & Associations: The birds associated with the month of Reed are the owl and goose, the color is grass green, and the gemstone is clear green jasper. Symbols of this Celtic month are The White Hound, The Stone, the Planet Pluto (Pwyll), The Fire Feast of Samhain Dis, Pwyll, and Arawn. Identified with the submerged or hidden dryad, The Month of Reed represents the mysteries of death. In fact the Fire Feast of Samhain celebrates the*

dead and on Samhain, the boundary between the Otherworld and this world dissolve. It is a night of great divination. Or in another fashion, it represents the hidden roots to all life. The Month of Reed is associated with being both a savior and custodian. Pwyll, the Celtic ruler of the Otherworld was given "The Stone", one of four treasures given to him for safekeeping. The Stone represents the right of the kings and queen to have divine power. Thus the Reed is also the symbol of Royalty. The White Hounds represent the dogs that guard the lunar mysteries. The Elm tree is a tree of Saturn and is associated with the element of earth. It is sacred to Odin, Hoenin and Todr. The elm is also associated with the day of Tuesday.

Magickal usage: The month of Elm / Reed is a good month for using music in magick, especially music made by bagpipes and flutes, and also for doing divination. Elm is sometimes said to symbolize the dark side of the psyche and so can be used in psychic workings. The Elm is commonly known as "the elf friend". If you desire to have contact with wood elves, pick a grove of Elm trees and sit under them and sing. Around about dawn, the elves will have gotten over their initial shyness and come out to join in the singing. Elm trees are also thought to provide a channel for the communication with divas. To get an Elm tree to help you in this quest, offerings can be brought to a favorite tree and left. The best offerings are wine, mead, tobacco, coins and sage. Tiny twigs of Elm can be worn in a bag around a child's neck as a charm to produce eloquent speech in later life. Elm wood may be bound with a yellow cord and burned to prevent gossip. The Elm represents primordial female powers and therefore the Elm is a tree with great protective qualities. The wood from the Elm can be made into talismans and charms that can be worn for protection. The Elm also has the qualities of regeneration, boldness and fidelity, and so added to its protective qualities, it is excellent when given as a good luck token to departing friends. Using Elm in spellwork adds stability to the spell. According to Edain McCoy in her article: Willow for love, Oak for strength

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of Samhain Dis, Pwyll, (Pluto) and Arawn.

Yew

The Yew is sacred to Hecate, and the Crone aspect of the Triple Goddess; both are guardians of the Underworld, death and the afterlife

The Yew is considered to be the most potent tree for protection against evil, a means of connecting to your ancestors, a bringer of dreams and otherworld journeys and a symbol of the old magic. In hot weather it gives off a resinous vapour which shamans inhaled to gain visions. Yew wood was regarded as especially magical to the Celts, due to its connection with the dead and the ancestors which were deeply respected.

The Yew tree, or Yew wood, the Tree ogham Idho, is the link to spiritual guidance through your ancestors, guides and guardians in the Otherworld. The Yew is here to remind us that there are other levels of existence beyond this material plane. By understanding the illusionary nature of the life we have created for ourselves, we can live our lives more consciously. Often death is fraught with a sense of loss, but the Yew can teach us to see death as a form of transformation and that it is never final.

The knowledge we gain from the Yew makes it an extremely important tree for healing. It can help us overcome our fear of our own death and, by freeing us from this fear, bring us a greater stillness in our lives. Death heralds the ending of something. It may be a physical death, or the death of our old selves, an old way of life or an old way of looking at things. Each end, each death, is a new beginning, hope, future and transformation. Sometimes things need to end or die before the new can begin, and understanding rebirth always requires seeing

beyond our limitations.

What do you see, what do you feel?

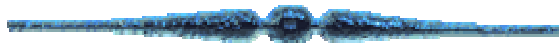
Everyone will experience something different as it brings to you only what you need.
